Dismissals-

4 speech students 2 will be dismissed at the beginning of next year

Elementary/Intermediate has picked up several resource students this year which will affect Jr. High and High School beginning next year.

Dr. Flores is conducting the TEACCH workshop here in June and we will train para's and third grade teachers as well as one parent using stimulus funds.

Extended year school has 11 students this year the largest number in recent years. It will include three one week sessions no more than two weeks apart to ensure the least amount of regression possible for the students.
