- The new cell phone policy is generally working well in grades 6-9 with many phones filling the phone boxes. Grades 10-12 do not have many phones turned into the phone boxes, but teachers report that they are not seeing any phones in the classroom and that student engagement has increased.
- Behavior referral data:
 - JH Behavior referrals in April decreased for the third month in a row, With January (69), February (50), March (40) and April (31) The most frequent behaviors for April were Disruption, Technology, Tardy/Skip, Threats/intimidation, and minor aggressive act.
 - HS Behavior referrals decreased in February (23) and March (12), then increased in April (24). The most frequent behaviors for April were Technology Violation and Tardy/Skip.
