- Concerns with 2024-25 changes at Student Forum Discussion
 - "The lack of communication feels alienating." Students felt it would have been more helpful and easy if plans for next year could've been shared with the community sooner.
 - "We should all get to be a bigger part of these discussions, but before they make final decisions." Students wish they were consulted with more before big changes are implemented. They recognize that the district does make an effort at this, but believe these efforts could be expanded upon.
 - "WIN has been the best time to do homework, especially when I dont get home from practice until pretty late [at night]... with a 7th class and not having WIN, I dont know how i'm supposed to get all my work done." Many are worried that having an extra class and not having WIN could be one of the more straining parts of these schedule changes. They are curious if staff will be considerate of these adjustments when assigning work and due dates.
