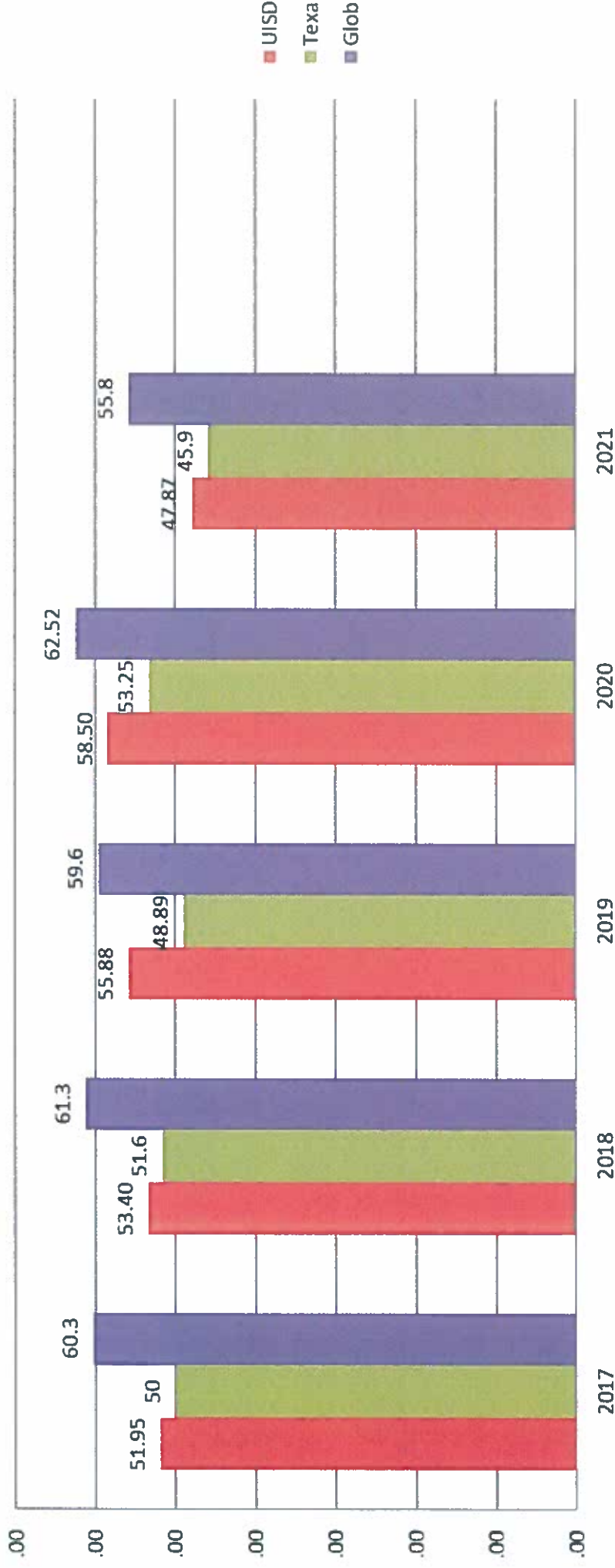

Standard levels:

Scholar with Distinction: Granted to students who receive an average score of at least 3.5 on all AP Exams taken, and scores of 3 or higher on five or more of these exams

National AP Scholar: Granted to the one male and one female student in each U.S. state and the District of Columbia with scores of 3 or higher on the greatest number of AP Exams, and then the highest average score (at least 3.5) on all AP Exams taken

National AP Scholar: Granted to students in the United States who receive an average score of at least 4 on all AP Exams taken, and scores of 4 or higher on eight or more of these exams (The AP program is discontinuing awards that encourage students to take large number of exams for 2021-2022 and thereafter)

Key Information: Shows the cost saved by students accepting college credit for an OnRamps dual enrollment course. The figure includes the sum of the average tuition, fee, textbook and materials costs of Texas public four-year institutions multiplied by the number of students in the district who earned and accepted college credit. If students are enrolled in more than one OnRamps course, they may earn and accept credit in more than one course

- Average tuition cost for one college course at a Texas public four-year institution: \$1,010
- Average textbook cost for one college course at a Texas public four-year institution: \$120
- Number of students who earned and accepted OnRamps college course credit in the district: 146
