Last year showed us that flexibility and creativity are sometimes necessary in how we educate our students. I want to take this opportunity to thank students, staff, and parents for all of their hard work, flexibility, and support over the span of the pandemic. After last year of functioning in fully virtual, and then in a hybrid setting, we are excited to return to five full days of in-person instruction for the 2021-2022 school year. #### **OHA SPONSORED COVID-19 TESTING IN SCHOOLS**

NKN Middle School will offer two types of testing programs this year: diagnostic and screening. By identifying infections early, testing helps keep COVID-19 transmission low and students in school for in person learning, sports, and extracurricular activities. Both programs are available at school for those families who want to participate.

**Diagnostic testing** is the testing of students who develop symptoms at school or are exposed to COVID-19 at school. This testing program was rolled out in January 2021and was available for all middle school students once we started hybrid in March of last year. To participate, a parent consent form is required to be on file in the office. If interested, please fill out this <u>form</u> and send it to the office.

**Screening testing** is the testing of students who do not have symptoms of, or exposure to, COVID-19. Screening testing targets unvaccinated students, but enrollment is open to anyone and vaccination status is not verified. Student screening testing is offered through partnership with several laboratories across Oregon and is completely confidential. The screening testing is voluntary, parents will have to sign their student up in order for students to participate. I will share more information about this program as receive it.
