Federal E-Rate Funding Update

Board Goal: VI. Growth, Change and Fiscal Responsibility

Purpose of Report

The purpose of this workshop item is to give the Board a chance to hear the status of the current ERate offering for DISD and how we have benefited.

Objectives

- Update on current status of outstanding projects (optical network 2016)
- Update on new projects (3 outstanding school networks)
- SB 1 \$25 million for E-Rate, to get Texas matching federal funds that improve highspeed broadband connectivity for all Texas public schools
- Update Region 11 Fiber/optical project
- Internet connections under ERate
- Future of the Telephone system

Operational Impact

The District receives a 60% discount from the FCC Schools and Library Division (E-Rate) as gauged by the districts free and reduced percentages. All equipment and services the district applies for ERate funding will result in the 40% encumbrance. In the projects above, the district portion for the optical equipment will be approximate cost of \$1,000,000 and the approximate cost for the network equipment for the 3 elementary schools is \$133,492.36. This does not include SB 1 as it has not been approved as of yet.

Results

Denton ISD will benefit from the optical equipment by increasing the speed of data between schools, Internet, Region 11 and DISD connected devices. We will also be a hub site for Region 11 and connections to local ISD's from Denton ISD. Denton ISD continues to receive Category 2 funding for Internet services. We have multiple connections to the Internet. 1. THEnet – T-1 connection from DISD to UT Dallas via UT Austin. 2. LEARN – (2Gb) connects UNT, TWU and Denton ISD to SMU Frisco then to Downtown Dallas. 3. Zayo – (10gb) which is the main Internet source for Denton ISD. 3A(the Zayo connection will be disconnected and be provided by Region 11 as their ERate is qualified)
