

Proclamation Recognizing Texas Gifted and Talented Awareness Week

WHEREAS, the Texas Legislature has formally designated the first full week of April as Gifted and Talented Awareness Week in the State of Texas, establishing it as an official state-recognized observance; and

WHEREAS, Gifted and Talented students exhibit high-performance capability in an intellectual, creative, or artistic area; and

WHEREAS, Gifted and Talented students possess an unusual capacity for leadership or excels in a specific academic field; and

WHEREAS, Gifted and Talented students require differentiated and appropriately challenging educational experiences; and

WHEREAS, Texas public schools are required under the Texas Education Code to identify and serve Gifted and Talented students through equitable, research-based, and high-quality instructional programs; and

WHEREAS, recognizing Gifted and Talented Awareness Week affirms the importance of meeting the diverse academic, social, and emotional needs of gifted learners in order to maximize their potential and contributions; and

WHEREAS, the Brownsville Independent School District is committed to providing rigorous learning opportunities, professional learning for educators, and supportive programming that fosters excellence, innovation, and academic growth for Gifted and Talented students;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED, that the Brownsville Independent School District hereby recognizes the first full week of April as Texas Gifted and Talented Awareness Week and encourages students, educators, families, and the community to celebrate and support the achievements and needs of Gifted and Talented learners.
