The Superintendent will develop and maintain District emergency plans for <u>each school</u>, <u>department</u>, <u>and other facilities in the District</u> <u>fire and other threats</u> and will coordinate such plans with the local <u>law enforcement</u>, <u>police</u>, fire, <u>medical</u> and hospital authorities as necessary. <u>Training components for staff and students shall be included in the Superintendent's emergency plans</u>.

"Emergency response plans are confidential and exempt from public disclosure." The District shall not release emergency response plans to the public as part of a public records request. [A.R.S. 41-1803(G)]

The plans will be in accordance with minimum standards developed jointly by the Department of Education and the Division of Emergency Management within the Department of Emergency and Military Affairs. The plans will specify conditions under which evacuation of school buildings will occur. The plans will also designate specific emergency drills to be conducted. Local responders shall periodically The fire department shall be invited to review the plan(s).

Emergency plans developed by the Superintendent will be presented annually to the Board. Each supervisory administrator shall have a copy of the emergency plans.
