







# Guidance Lesson with Mrs. Broaddus

Mrs. Broaddus recently delivered guidance lessons focused on bullying and cyberbullying prevention. During these sessions, students reviewed the definition of bullying, the different types (physical, verbal, social, and cyber), and the impact bullying can have on individuals and school culture.

Students also discussed responsible digital behavior, the long-term effects of online actions, and strategies for responding to and reporting cyberbullying. Emphasis was placed on being an upstander rather than a bystander, using respectful communication, and understanding the consequences of inappropriate online conduct.

These lessons support our ongoing efforts to promote a safe, respectful learning environment and align with district expectations for student behavior and digital citizenship.
