## December Board Report Ozona Middle School

Curriculum and Instruction – we are finishing up our cycle 3 instruction. We have had another round of benchmarks and are working on data folders and CIA notebook additions for this cycle. We have had lots of research projects this cycle, especially in science (Newton's Law and Solar System) and GT. We have had Tiffany Esparza come in and help some teachers with further implementation of the clicker system. As we begin to prepare for cycle 4 we will again use our instructional focus calendars and C Scope Year at a Glance to guide pacing and student expectation. As we move into cycle 4, we will have a more focused effort toward state test prep with our Mock STAAR exams, as well as other strategies. We have also had an ESC social studies specialist come in and spend the day with our school working with teachers to improve student performance through better use of C Scope strategies and finding resources to utilize C Scope lesson templates. All of these efforts have improved student performance through improved classroom instruction.

**School Improvement** - we have had our first round of instructional coaching at OMS for reading, math and social studies teachers. (IF you will recall, we had instructional coaching for science last year.) These coaches will come into classrooms to observe student learning, look at data and guide teachers as to how to improve student performance in their classroom this year. Our next Campus Targeted Student Analysis Review and Student Level Review submission will be due in January. We are working on targeting areas of weakness through our benchmarking each cycle, so that we can respond to gaps in class room instruction and through RtI time. These efforts have us look at individual student performance as well as group performance.

Homework House – As a Title 1 campus, one of the things that we have found to be most successful this year is to have an extended day program to help students complete homework and study for benchmarks. Our Homework House is open Monday –Thursday from 3:35-5:00 and we have usually 15-25 students in attendance. Students get help completing homework assignments, catching up on missed work from absences and preparing for benchmarks. I am in there every day, as well as, Coach Clayton and grade-level team members. Our homework completion percentage has improved from being in the 70's to the upper 80's and 90's though the implementation of this intervention. Our failure list has also been positively impacted by this intervention. While we still have students on the list, their averages are not as low.

**Extra-Curricular** – We had a fantastic showing in the UIL meet. We had lot of student participation, right at 70 students which is almost half of our population, and out of 7 schools we placed 3<sup>rd</sup>. Our students and teachers did an excellent job with preparation and participation. We were well represented at the district meet.
