Item Title: 2021 State Assessment Update
Description: On December 10 the Texas Education Agency (TEA) sent out correspondence stating TEA will not issue A-F accountability ratings for the 2020-2021 school year; however, in order to gather student data for the schools & districts to use state assessments will continue this school year with the administrations of the State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness (STAAR®), STAAR Alternate 2, the Texas English Language Assessment System (TELPAS), and TELPAS Alternate.

South San Antonio ISD Spring State Assessment Update

Feb. 12, 2021

- The Texas Education Agency (TEA) will not issue A–F accountability ratings for the 2020–2021 school year.
- Student Success Initiative (SSI) Requirements Waived- There will be only ONE administration of STAAR grades 5 and 8 mathematics and reading.
- All students in grades 3–8 will take the STAAR. Student must be present at a
 monitored testing session and must be supervised by a trained test administrator.

 Students in grades 3-8 who are remote learners may opt for remote learning
 instruction if they will not be choosing to attend in-person for their respective STAAR
 administration.
- Students enrolled in specific high school courses are required by federal and state law
 to take corresponding STAAR end-of-course (EOC) assessments. Students who miss the
 opportunity to take EOC assessments for STAAR or STAAR Alternate 2 will be missing
 an opportunity to meet assessment graduation requirements.
- Districts can submit a waiver to require students who are not scheduled to take that assessment to learn remotely on a scheduled testing day. This allows campuses to prioritize in-building attendance for students who are scheduled to test.
- STAAR assessments can be taken in both a paper-based or an online platform (students testing on a device while in-building). This year the online testing window is extended for both STAAR 3–8 assessments and STAAR end-of-course (EOC) assessments:
 - five weeks for the April 2021 STAAR grades 3-8 and EOC assessments (April 6-May 7)
 - five weeks for the May 2021 STAAR EOC assessments (May 4–June 4)
 - five weeks for the May 2021 STAAR grades 3–8 assessments (May 11–June 11)
 - two weeks for the June 2021 STAAR EOC assessments (June 22–July 2)
- TEA is not able to extend STAAR paper testing windows because of the time required to ship, process, and score paper testing materials and maintain reporting dates.
