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Member Seliga Punyko asked if all day kindergarten should be added to the District's legislative platform.

Board discussion took place regarding all-day kindergarten. Member Johnston asked if there is anything in the Legislature that bans all day Kindergarten. Mr. Soberg stated that there is not, however, there is not sufficient funding to make all-day kindergarten fully funded and explained that pupil weighting was increased a few years ago, but just by .1 for an increase to only .6 pupil unit, whether the District offers full or half-day kindergarten.

Member Johnston stated that he would support the motion, however, believed that the topic of this meeting could have taken place at a regular school board meeting. Chair Wasson explained the special meeting was needed due to Mr. Soberg's timeline with the legislative session.
