

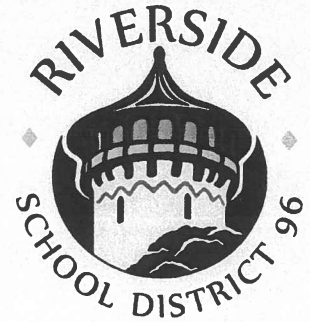

On November 10, 2025, Riverside School District 96 received your above-referenced Freedom of Information Act request. This letter will serve as the School District's response.

Records Requested:

1. Copies of public records from [REDACTED] service log minutes for [REDACTED], including service logs from 3/12/25-11/7/25.
2. Any and all email correspondence between staff regarding Arie from August 2024 to present day.

District Response:

The records that are responsive to your request, if they exist, are not subject to disclosure in that they are statutorily exempt pursuant to the following FOIA provisions:

- FOIA Section 7(1)(a), "Information specifically prohibited from disclosure by federal or State law or rules and regulations implementing federal or State law."
- FOIA Section 7.5(r): "Information prohibited from being disclosed by the Illinois School Student Records Act [105 ILCS 10/1 et seq.]"
