Congratulations Jasmine Windsor and Brendan Sempf for earning 4.0 grade point averages and sharing the title of Valedictorian for the graduating class of 2020 from Boyceville High School. The Academic Excellence Scholarship, which goes to the graduating senior with the highest gpa at the end of 7 semesters, can only be given to one individual. Following the tiebreakers set by board policy, I am recommending to the Board of Education that Jasmine Windsor be named the Academic Excellence in Education Scholarship recipient. I would also recommend that the following students be listed as alternates in the given order by gpa: Brendan Sempf (4.000), Noelle Wheeldon (3.987), Ana Evenson (3.973), and Caitlyn Pelikan (3.954). This group of students represents the Top 10% of the Graduating Class and will represent Boyceville at the Dunn County Excellence in Education Banquet in the spring.

We are again going to have freshman transition meetings during our parent teacher conferences on February 24th and 27th. The meetings will begin at 6:00PM and be held in the commons. Included in the transition meeting will be information about how to help find the resources high schoolers need, opportunities for them to take advantage of, and class registration.
