Re: Coppell Middle School East Athletic Complex Fence Replacement – 2017 Bond Project #30

As part of the 2017 Bond Projects (e.g. Project #30), Coppell Middle School East is to receive new 8 foot tall ornamental wrought iron fencing around the athletic complex that is compliant with city code. This is in conjunction with the construction of the new track and turf at the school.

Louis Macias was able to secure from PDQ Fence Company the same pricing per foot as we received for the CMS North fencing completed earlier this year. The removal of the existing chain link fence and installation of the new fence can be accomplished for a turn-key price of \$89,292.00. The new fence will require a permit from the city, but is not required to go through the City Planning and Zoning Process. This is the same fencing that is around a portion of Buddy Echols Field and around Coppell Middle School North. Please see photo below.

The Interlocal Contract purchasing method as provided in the Texas Education Code 44.031 was used to obtain proposals through the Educational Purchasing Cooperative of North Texas Contract #1207.

Since this is a dual use facility that will be utilized by both Coppell ISD and the City of Coppell, the city has agreed to pay half of the total cost. Therefore, Coppell ISD will ultimately only be responsible for \$44,646.00 of the total cost.

Resolution: That the Coppell ISD Board of Trustees approve PDQ Fence Company as the vendor to complete the athletic complex fence replacement at Coppell Middle School East at a total cost of \$89,292.00.
