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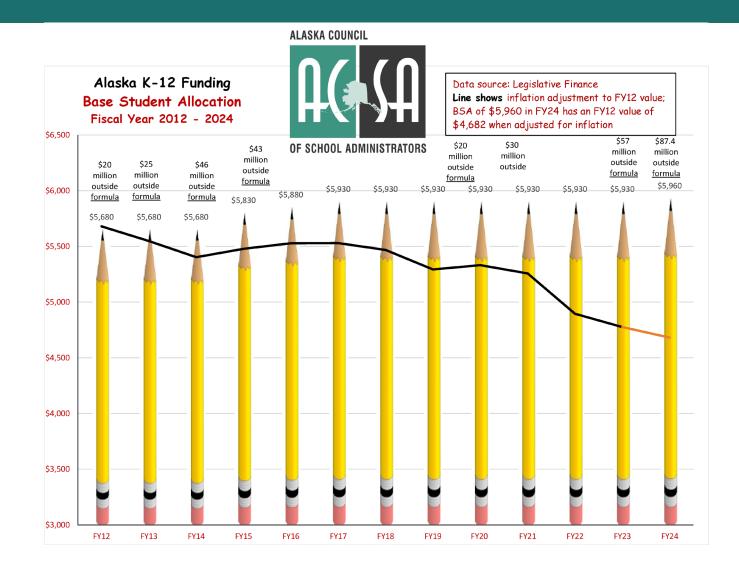

### District Buying Power



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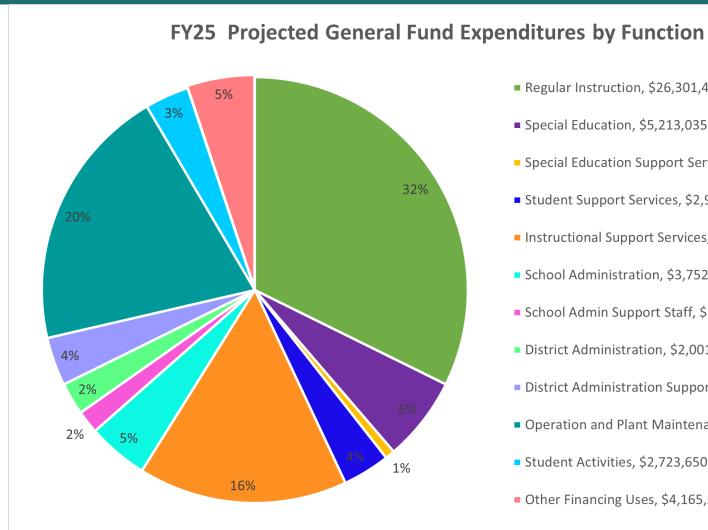

### Executive Summary

In February, 2024, the NSBSD Administration held budget hearings with all the school site Principals and representatives of the School Advisory Council.

The purpose of the meetings was to further improve communication and transparency by:

- providing an overview of the financial position of the District including revenues and expenses
- consulting with sites and confirming FTE's, added duty contracts and operational needs
- receiving and discussing requests specific to each location for consideration during budgeting

Over the 11 meetings, a series of consistent themes were discussed which included:

- the financial situation of education in the State of Alaska and the North Slope Borough School District;
- the decline in the revenues of the District (NSB, State, Federal) and the impact on operations;
- the critical importance of student attendance on lifting achievement and a discussion about areas of improvement;
- the urgent need for learning and coaching interventions across all sites;
- staffing designations and Teacher Pupil Ratios,
- budget reductions, targeted spending and alternative funding sources;
- added duty contracts and specific site requests;
- site based goals for the future and ways the District could help.
- the role of the SAC as an advisory body and the role of the Board as a governance authority
