Dear Parents,

In an effort to relieve the number of students presently attending Hicks Elementary, a proposal has been presented to the Board of Trustees to rezone students to Stewarts Creek Elementary beginning with the 2011-12 school year. Your address is included in the proposal. Please see the map on the reverse side of this letter. If you live in the shaded area, your children would attend Stewarts Creek Elementary.

This proposal would result in Hicks Elementary having approximately 144 fewer students or a total of 647 rather than 791. Stewarts Creek can easily accommodate these students bringing its projected enrollment to 490 students.

Traditionally, the Board of Trustees has allowed certain students and their siblings to remain at the present school. This would apply to students who will be FIFTH graders at their current school next year. All other students would be required to attend the school to which they are zoned. A letter will be sent to those students impacted by the boundary changes along with a school choice form for those who are allowed to stay at their current campus. This letter will be delivered after the boundaries have been approved by the Board of Trustees.

As has been the standard for LISD, the Board of Trustees will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, January 25, 2011 at Peters Colony Elementary starting at 6:30 p.m. The public hearing is not required by law however, LISD officials want to ensure all community concerns are heard before the boundaries are adopted.
