 As our 2022-23 Activities year comes to an end and I reflect back Ranger Athletics had a pretty wonderful year overall. Three Section team championships (Jazz & Kick Dance, Girls Basketball) two Section team Runner-up (Football, Boys Track) and numerous All-State Individuals (Tori Oehrlein-GBB, JP Fitzpatrick-Wrestling & Track, Jordan Mount-Track, Raylin Daratis-Kick Dance, Brenna Nelson-Kick Dance, Cami Armbrust-Jazz Dance, Hannah Pederson-Jazz Dance).

Athletics Updates

Softball

• The Lady Rangers finished the season with a record of 4-17 overall in Coach McDonald's first season. They fell to Greenway/Nashwauk-Keewatin 8-0 in the 1st Round of the Section 7AA Playoffs. Lilli Young was named to the Mid-State All Conference team and Josie Schaefer, Sammie Hachey, Brooke Johnson and Brynn Hollenhorst were named as Honorable Mention for the Mid-State Conference.

Baseball

Our Baseball team finished 5-16 overall on the season and lost to Rock Ridge 11-2 in the 1st Round of the Section
7AA Playoffs. It was a young squad for Coach Syrstand and Jenkins with many games being close right down to
the last inning. Carter Decent was named to the Mid-State All Conference team while Keyon Wesner, Brayden
Holmvig, Jacob Millsop, Max Erickson and Ky Gressman were all named as Honorable Mention for the Mid-State.

Track & Field

• The Ranger Track & Field team qualified 12 athletes to the State Championships this season. Jordan Mount qualified in four events becoming only the 2nd ever athlete in C-I History to do so (Parker Robinson-2003). Mount was named to the All-State team in two events by placing 3rd in both the Triple Jump and Long Jump. John Paul Fitzpatrick was also named All-State by finishing 9th in the Pole Vault. The Boys finished 2nd as a team in the Section 7A Championships and had three individual Section Champions while the Girls finished 5th and had one individual Section Champion. Three School Records were broken this season, the Boys 4x200m Relay (Evan Rydberg, Noah Larson, Jordan Mount, JP Fitzpatrick) and the Long Jump and Triple Jump were broken by Jordan Mount.

Boys & Girls Golf

The Boys and Girls Golf teams wrapped up their season at the Section Championships. It was an extremely
challenging season for the Golfers with the weather during the Spring. A big positive were the numbers of
athletes who participated and many younger ones so the future is bright for the Golfers.
