TOPIC: LCTC Engineering Lab Furniture and Technology Purchase

RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District approve the purchase of new furniture and technology for the Livonia Career Technical Center (LCTC) Engineering lab. Furniture to be purchased from Interior Environments, Novi, MI in the amount of \$55,786, and new technology from CDW-G, Chicago, IL in the amount of \$57,476. The total cost is \$113,262.

RATIONALE:

LCTC is in the process of updating selected program classrooms through 61(a)1 state CTE grant funds. Based on the age and current condition of the furniture and technology, LCTC is requesting an update to the Engineering Lab. Through contract pricing the total cost for these purchases from Interior Environments and CDW-G is \$113,262.
