New Business:

A motion was made by Mrs. Schulz, seconded by Mr. Hatch, to approve consent agenda items as follows: 1) consider approval of minutes of the Regular Meeting of January 19, 2026; Board Workshop of February 4, 2026; 2) consider approval of Bills and Warrants as of January 31, 2026; 3) consider approval of Library Resource Materials purchase list; 4) approval for Director of Special Education to perform adjunct teaching services at Texas A&M University-Kingsville; 5) approval of Cisco FLEX Licensing Agreement renewal 2026-2029. The motion carried 4-0 with the record vote as follows: Luckenbach, Hatch, Wells, and Schulze all voting yes. Mr. Batek did not record a vote. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Mr. Hatch, seconded by Mr. Wells, to approve the purchase of one Special Education Bus from Thomas Bus Gulf Coast GP, Inc. in the amount of \$151,500.00 using the Buyboard Purchasing Cooperative Contract Number 722-23. The motion carried 4-0 with the record vote as follows: Luckenbach, Hatch, Wells, and Schulze all voting yes. Mr. Batek did not record a vote. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Mrs. Schulze, seconded by Mr. Hatch, to approve the ranking of the Contractors for construction services on the Middle School Chemical Injection Stabilization Services Project (Bond 2023) as proposed by Administration, which offers the best value to the District based on the published selection of criteria and the ranking of the evaluations from the proposers pursuant to Texas Government Code Ch. 2269, Subchapter D, and authorize the Superintendent or her designee to negotiate an agreement with the top-ranked Contractor, Earth Lok Soil Stabilizer, and if an agreement cannot be reached to terminate negotiations and go onto the next-ranked Contractor and so on until an agreement can be reached, and further authorize the Superintendent to execute an agreement in a form approved by legal counsel and report back to the Board at the next meeting regarding the final agreement. The motion carried 3-1 with the record vote as follows: Luckenbach, Hatch, and Schulze all voting yes and Wells casting the dissenting vote. Mr. Batek did not record a vote. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Mrs. Schulze, seconded by Mr. Hatch, to approve the resolution regarding the Acceptance and Final Payment for Construction of East Elementary School Remodel Project (2023 Bond). The motion carried 4-0 with the record vote as follows: Luckenbach, Hatch, Wells, and Schulze all voting yes. Mr. Batek did not record a vote. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Mr. Hatch, seconded by Mrs. Schulze, to approve the resolution regarding the Acceptance and Final Payment for Construction of East Elementary School Remodel Project (2023 Bond). The motion carried 4-0 with the record vote as follows: Luckenbach, Hatch, Wells, and Schulze all voting yes. Mr. Batek did not record a vote. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Mr. Wells, seconded by Mrs. Schulze, to approve the Calallen ISD calendar for 2026-2027 as presented. The motion carried 4-0 with the record vote as follows: Luckenbach, Hatch, Wells, and Schulze all voting yes. Mr. Batek did not record a vote. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Mr. Hatch, seconded by Mrs. Schulze, to approve the Bond 2024 remaining funds budget recommendation to proceed with CHS Baseball and Softball Lighting Upgrade/Replacement Project estimated at \$450,000. The motion carried 4-0 with the record vote as follows: Luckenbach, Hatch, Wells, and Schulze all voting yes. Mr. Batek did not record a vote. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Mr. Wells, seconded by Mr. Hatch, to approve the implementation of Senate Bill 11 at Calallen ISD. The motion carried 3-2 with the record vote as follows: Wells, Hatch and Batek all voting yes and Luckenbach and Schulze casting the dissenting votes. Motion passed.
