SUBJECT: <u>APPROVAL OF MATHEMATICS TEXTBOOK ADOPTION</u>

BOARD GOAL: All students will achieve educational excellence.

FISCAL NOTE: N/A

Background Information:

- According to the Texas Administrative Code §66.104: Each local board of trustees of a school district shall adopt a policy for selecting instructional materials. Final selections must be recorded in the minutes of the board of trustees or governing body. The KISD Board of Trustees approved the 2006-2007 textbook selection process on November 27, 2006.
- According to EFAA Local: After examining all instructional materials adopted by the State Board and reflected on the multiple lists, the textbook selection committee shall select materials for use in the District and recommend the selections to the Board for ratification.
- Local Policy EFAA also states that the Superintendent or designee shall be responsible for coordinating the time frame for meetings of the committee and meetings of the Board to ensure compliance with state timelines.

Administrative Considerations:

- On January 25-26, 2007, a textbook adoption committee comprised of thirty-one mathematics teachers, grades 6-12, and three assistant principals convened to review all textbook options on the state conforming list.
- Two subcommittees were created (one representing grades 6-8; another representing grades 9-12) so that textbooks could be evaluated and reviewed by the appropriate teaching staff of each mathematics grade/course. Eight of the thirty-one teacher representatives (25%) serve on the district curriculum writing committees.
- Advertisements in the Keller Citizen and the Keller ISD website invited the public to review textbooks and provide input. Public viewing occurred February 2-3, 2007 in the Board Room at the Education Center.

<u>AP Statistics</u> Pearson-Addison Wesley, *Stats: Modeling the World*
