Strengths & Celebrations

Math

- Winter Growth Goal progress:
 - 2022-23: 74.9%
 - 2023-24: 83.9%
 - 2024-25: 85.9%
- Every grade increased the percentage of students at grade level from fall to winter.
 - Four grades improved by 15+ percentage points.
 - 2nd grade: Increased from 25.7% to 56.3% at grade level.
- Overall, students at grade level grew from 36.8% to 52.7%.

Reading

- Students at grade level grew from 36.8% to 42.2%.
- 73.8% met their Winter Growth Goal.
- Kindergarten: Increased 13 percentage points; 5th grade: Increased 18 points.
- 60% scored at or above the 61st percentile for literary text.

Action Plan

Math

- Completion of the Eureka Math Implementation Guide.
 - Use of the implementation guide with training and coaching to provide consistency and increase the effectiveness of teaching the Eureka Math lessons.
- Align Number Corner with Eureka Math
- Implementation of Number Corner K-5.
