Principal's Remarks:

- Talked about holiday parties, the district nutrition policy, holiday trees in schools to make sure no issues are cropping up in school.

Previous Business:

The district is now planning on adding some new signage and painting to the school parking lot to help with our on-going parking lot navigation issues.

New Business:

Discussed the information from the quarterly CEC meeting held November 29th. Wrote up a list of Partnerships Hiteon currently has. It would be helpful to have the district better define what criteria is used to determine who qualifies as a "partner" and whether there needs to be a distinction between partnerships through the school PTC organization versus those directly with the school.
