School Safety:

Parent Involvement

- Playground update We have a quote from Playkraft for replacing the net structure on the playground. The structure is \$14K (roughly), freight and installation labor is \$6K. We need to sign the agreement by 10/31 to lock in the price and avoid a 3% increase. We have \$14K in the budget and have applied to the Rotary to receive a grant for the \$6K freight and install. We won't know if we get the grant until December, so we need to approve increasing the budget to \$20K in the event we don't receive the grant before we can sign the contract. If we receive the grant, we will only spend \$14K.
- Spirit wear that was purchased on the new online platform was passed out to students on Thursday.
- Banner update We got renewals from Winn Homes, Endless Summer, Southern Oregon Compost.
- Trunk or Treat recap Kaci provided a recap. Everyone agreed the new set up was an improvement. We have room next year for 21 car spaces and 12 pop-ups. We originally thought we had room for 20 car spaces, but we could have fit one more.
 Suggestion was made to add a competition next year for the best set up and have the kids vote.
- Canned food drive will run for two weeks, December 1st-11th. Megan has
 volunteered to chair the event, but will need help collecting each morning so if you
 are interested please contact her. We keep track of points for each grade and make
 it a competition.
- Holiday Event is December 18th

• Turkey Trot will be happening on November 8th. PTO parents and NVHS leadership students will be volunteering to help guide families where to go on the trot.

Instruction

- On Monday, they are having the 20% data meeting, which is to review all kids who are in the red zone receiving interventions.
