
The AP Capstone program empowers students to:

- Apply skills in new situations and cross-curricular contexts.
- Collect and analyze information with accuracy and precision.
- Craft, communicate, and defend evidence-based arguments.
- * Practice disciplined and scholarly research skills while exploring relevant topics that appeal to their interests and curiosity.

- Implementation in Grades 10-11, 11-12, or 10 & 12
- School-based specializations or subject clusters

- Rigorous, standardized capstone experience can enhance existing capstone and research projects

Student Selection

- No specific eligibility requirements for AP Capstone
- Flexibility to offer AP Capstone at multiple grade levels
 - Consider student selection in the context of the existing school curriculum
 - Enhance student performance in AP content area instruction
 - Prepare students for success in the first year of higher education
