Teacher Laptops

• We were short teacher laptop because of several part time positions that we didn't expect. However, we were able to order 10 more laptops and get them all distributed.

Minico Laptops

• The 9th grade laptops are setup and ready to be handed out as soon as policies and procedures are decided on to handle the distribution and support. The goal is to hand them out around Labor Day.

Online Registration

- As usual, we had the online registration available for 6 grade students and older. This year we used a new system provided by PowerSchool. It ran very well and we anticipate to be able to enhance it to the point of registering all students online if parents wish too. Online registration only includes the updating of demographic information for a returning students.
- We were able to add the option of paying fees online for all the schools this year. We installed the software for the schools that didn't have it. Credit card readers were shipped defective and we had to return them and are still waiting for the replacements.

Food Service

• This year we are importing students from PowerSchool to Nutrikids, the lunch serving line software, on a daily basis. This will automate the creation and deactivation of students for food service and keep them up to date with current students.
