The ExCEL award is sponsored by the Minnesota State High School League and recognizes junior students who show excellence in leadership, education, and volunteer in their community.

Athletics/Activities Update:

- Dance Team: The Rangerettes are having another great season, with multiple top 3 finishes in both Jazz and Kick.
