**Youth Enrichment and Recreation:**

- Flag Football: We have 60 kids signed up for Sunday night Flag Football. Special thank you to all the varsity football players and Davin Thompson for assisting with this program!
- Youth Tackle Football: 24 kids have signed up for Youth Tackle which is run by Davin Thompson.
- Little Rockers: we have 39 Little Rockers. They will be performing at the September 14th home football game. The Little Rockers is led by Lauri Bauer.
- Junior Spikers: we have 33 Junior Spikers (which registration is still open). Junior Spikers is led by Jenny Helgemoe.
- We are currently taking youth dance class registrations. We will be offering the youth dance class along with two other dance classes: Strength and Technique Class and Musical Theater Class for our older dancers. Dance will begin on September 18.
- ATV Certification: we have 8 registered.

**Adult Enrichment and Recreation:**
