Updates for this school year:

1. Local Farm-to-School:

- a. Applied for and received \$124,000 to help subsidize purchases of foods grown or processed in Oregon from the 2015-17 Oregon Farm-to-School funds.
- b. Used Oregon Farm-to-School grant funds to subsidize purchases of foods for 2015 summer meals and 2015 school lunches. Included are organic apples and pears, sweet peppers, lettuce, kiwi, grapes. Farmers include; Bull Run Cider; Hood River Organics; Adelante Mujeres; Terra Nova Farm, Roamin Ranch Farm; Vial Family Farm.
- c. Attended Northwest Food Buyers Alliance Local Vendor food show to find new local vendors to purchase foods from.

2. Wellness Policy Revision Update

- a. The WP Advisory committee met three additional times since June to work on revised language to propose for the district's Wellness Policy and WP administrative regulations.

3. OHSU Dietetic Intern

- a. In June, 2015, hosted a two-week dietetic intern rotation in school foodservice.

4. USDA/ODE Child Nutrition Department

- a. Attended ODE CNP Advisory Council meeting May 7th.
