Introduction

Enrollment forecasting is an important part of the budgeting process. The administration focuses on enrollment trends and makes projections based on the best available information. Administrators utilize the Cohort Survival Projection Method as a framework for determining numbers of students. This method predicts what the future population will be based upon the survival of the existing residents and the births that will occur. Sources used for deriving enrollment projections were, five years of historical data, projection of live births from the Krofon report, and enrollment reports from December 2019.

Situation

Using this information, a cohort survival method spreadsheet was then developed, which then provided a five year forecast of the District's enrollment. Please note the projections confidence levels lower the further the projections go out into the future.

Based upon these projections here are some observations:

- Overall, the cohort projections show District 13's enrollment with a small continued growth through the years 2023-2024.
- Typically, the District has observed a 10-15 student increase in students attending 1st grade. It appears that many of the students are from full day kindergarten programs elsewhere.
- Westfield's seventh grade class (19-20) is larger than the average and moves through the cohort holding this large class size for one more year. The enrollment projections see another large sixth grade class in (21-22) and in (23-24).

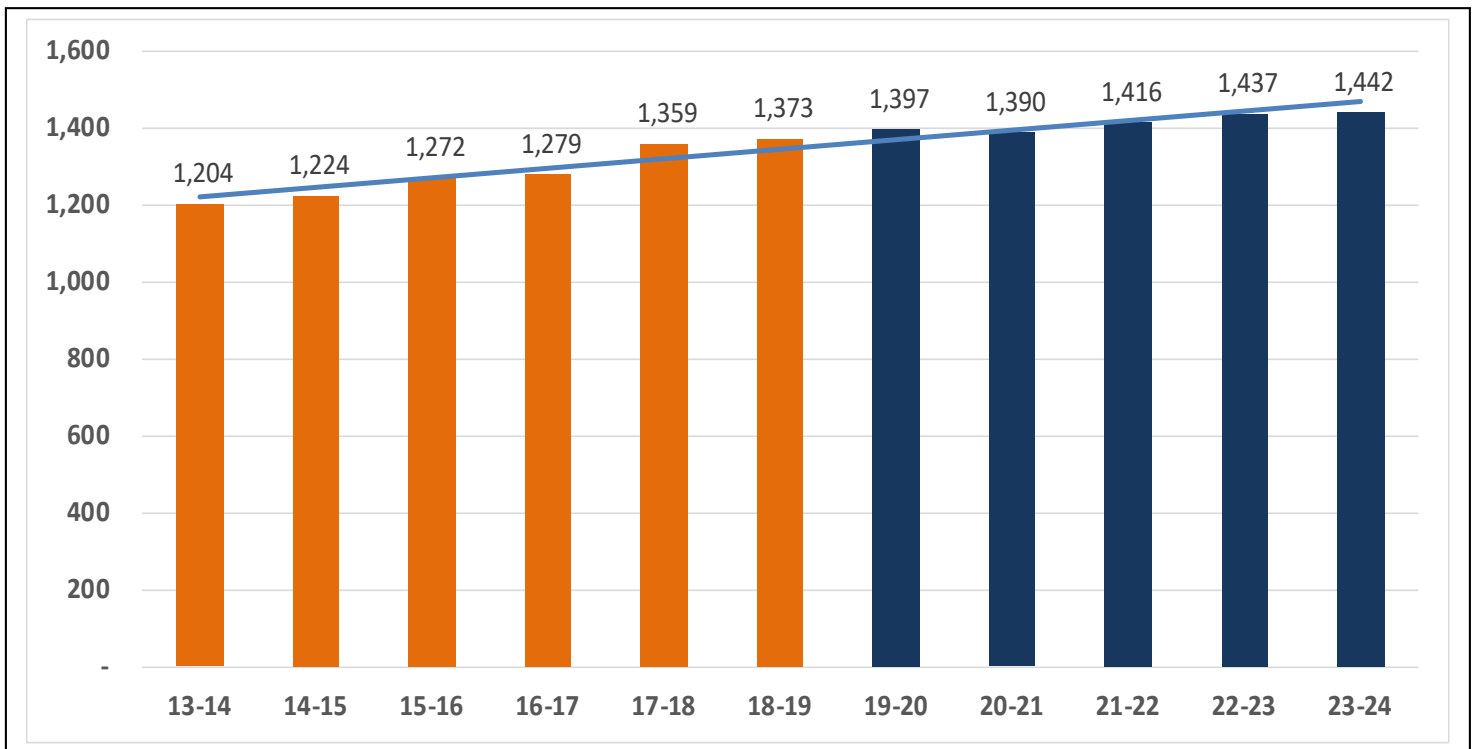

There is no recommendation for this is an informational report.

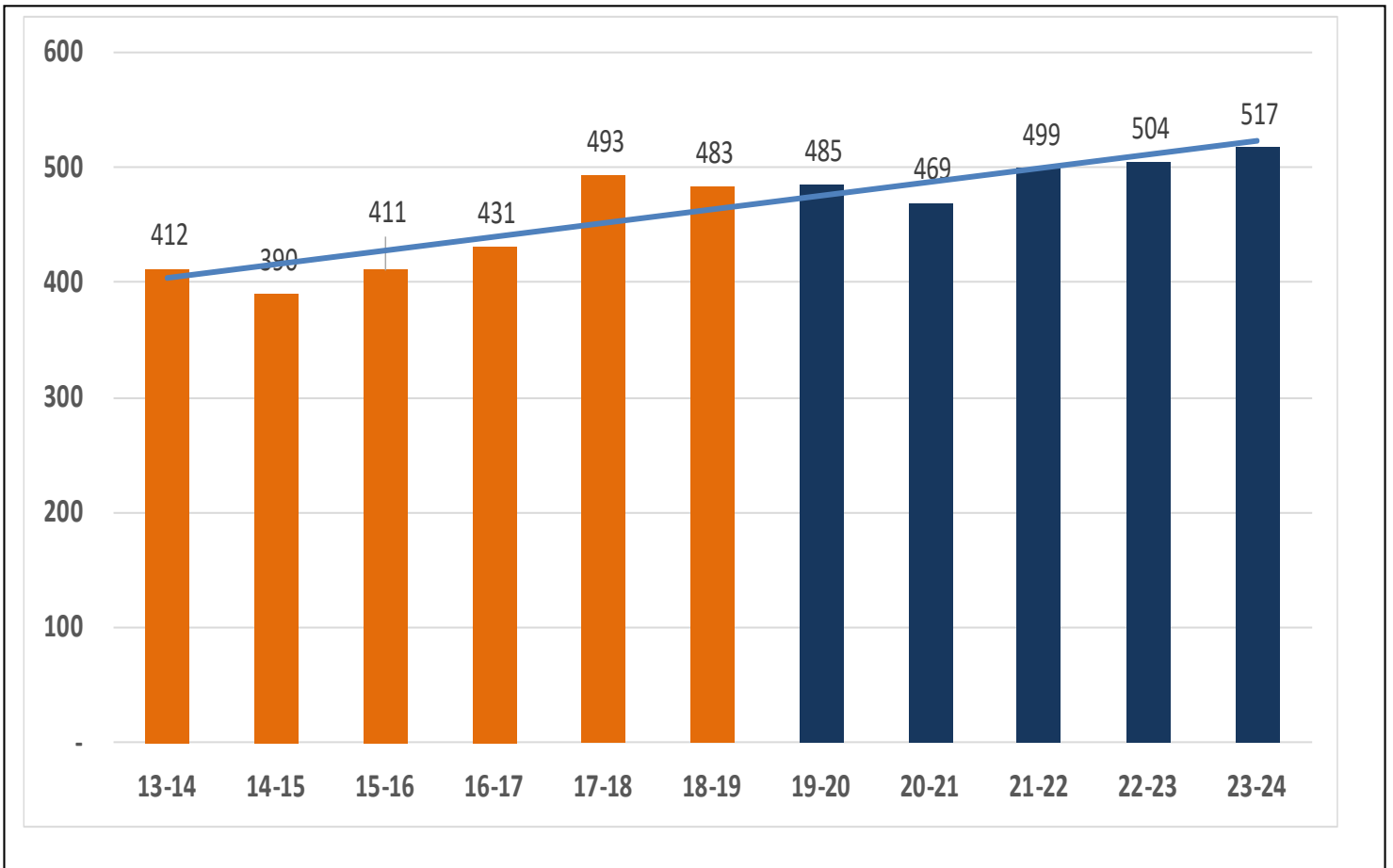

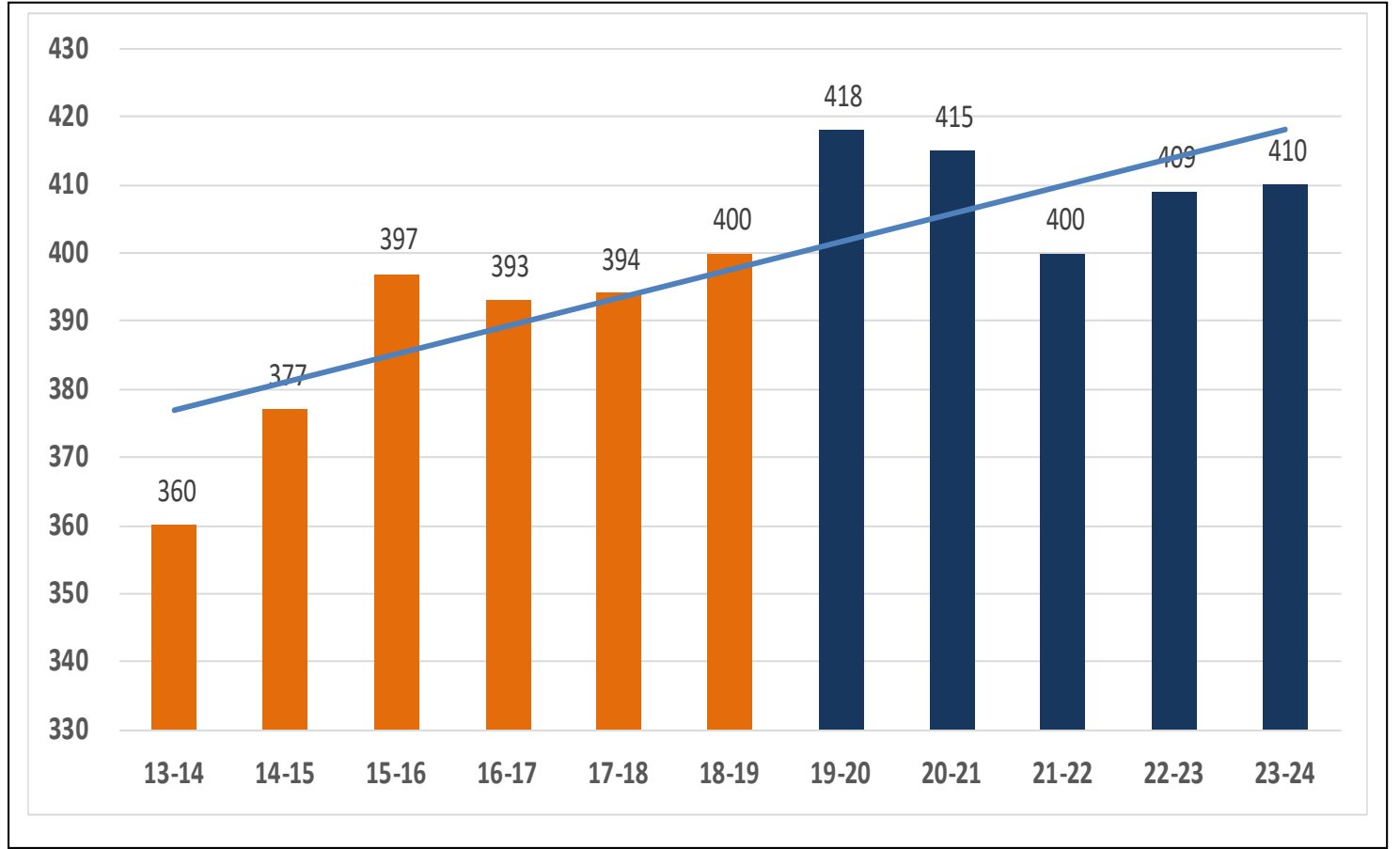
