What is Foundations? What does it teach?



Foundations is a multisensory and systematic phonics, spelling, and handwriting program that benefits all students. Foundations thoroughly teaches foundational skills, and significantly supports our state's reading, writing, and language standards.

Foundations presents the following concepts and skills systematically from unit to unit and year to year:

- Letter formation (handwriting, forming letters correctly)
- Phonological awareness (ability to recognize and manipulate the spoken parts of words, i.e. syllables)
- Phonemic awareness (ability to recognize and manipulate individual sounds in spoken words, i.e. c-a-t)
- Phonics (ability to correlate a sound with its individual letter or letter group, i.e. a says /a/)
- Word study, and advanced word study (focuses on the close investigation of words and word patterns)
- Irregular (trick) word instruction (words that cannot be sounded out and do not follow conventional rules and patterns of spelling, i.e. was, the)
- Vocabulary (the knowledge of words, their structure, use and meanings)
- Fluency (the ability to speak, read or write a language easily, accurately, and quickly)
- Comprehension strategies (the ability to read text, process it and understand its meaning)
- Written composition (spelling and handwriting)
