#### **CEMS Distance Delivery Updates**

- Unfortunately, the CES moved to a Distance Delivery Model on Thursday, January 6<sup>th</sup>, and the CMS a day later, on Friday, January 7<sup>th</sup>.
- CES Teachers/Staff utilized Thursday, January 6<sup>th</sup> as a planning day, with Distance Education beginning on Friday, January 7<sup>th</sup>. CMS Teachers/Staff utilized Friday, January 7<sup>th</sup> as a planning day, with CMS Distance Education beginning on Monday, January 10<sup>th</sup>.

• CEMS Staff along with CEMS Parents/Guardians & Students expect our schools to return to in-person instruction on Monday, January 17<sup>th</sup>. Whatever the Board can do to support that expectation as well as keep our schools open for in-person instruction would be appreciated.

#### **CMS Quarterly Electives**

- As CMS elective classes are quarter based, the start of Quarter 3 brought our middle school students choices for their new elective classes.
- First hour elective offerings include: Math Lab, Science Tech I, Careers, Volleyball Fundamentals, & SEALS, Band, Study Hall. Whereas, seventh hour elective offerings include: Drama, Audio Tech, Home Economics, & SEALS.
- The CMS staff works diligently to provide students with the electives of their choice. However, due certain classes needing to be capped given the specific nature of that particular class, at times the chosen elective may be "full," in which case students receive their alternative choice. In the CMS, we register students for their electives in the 8<sup>th</sup> grade first, then move to 7<sup>th</sup> grade, and then onto 6<sup>th</sup> grade last.

## **CEMS Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) Assessments**

- As you may recall, CEMS students in third through eighth grade will be administered the Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) Growth Assessments three (3) times this year (fall, winter, and spring). Second grade students will be tested twice, once in the winter and then again in the spring.
- Please make note that our winter testing session is open from now until March 31<sup>st</sup>. Tentatively, the CMS plans to MAP Test the week of January 17<sup>th</sup>, and the CES afterwards, the week of January 24<sup>th</sup>.
- CEMS parents/guardians of students in Grades 2-8 will be provided a copy of their child's MAP scores during CCSD's Parent/Teacher Conferences (2/17-2/18/22).

### **Virtual RTI/MTSS Effective Instruction Conference**

- The annual RTI/MTSS Effective Instruction Conference will be virtual once again this year and is taking place on Saturday, January 15<sup>th</sup> as well as Saturday, January 22<sup>nd</sup> through Sunday, January 23<sup>rd</sup>. The opportunity to attend was extended to all CCSD certified staff members.
- The virtual conference sessions available on Saturday (1/15) are optional and serve as a pre-conference for rural schools. The main conference will take place on Saturday (1/22) and Sunday (1/23).
- The keynote speakers at the conference this year are: Hadi Pavarti, Dr. Jo Boaler, Ken Shelton and Dr. Paul Hernandez.
- Conference sessions will cover strategies to support effective literacy and math instruction for all students, academic and behavioral supports and interventions, access and equity, and social and emotional learning.

#### **CEMS Athletics Updates**

- CMS Wrestling began on Wednesday, January 5<sup>th</sup>. CCSD's Superintendent, Mr. Reitan, was contacted by Klawock Superintendent, Jim Holien, in regard to potential assistance with Klawock's Wrestling Program this season/year.
- Mr. Reitan contacted Mr. Chuck Hanson (who is currently coaching CMS Wrestling), in which Mr. Hanson agreed to assist Klawock with their wrestling program as well. Currently, Coach Hanson has twenty-six (26) wrestlers participating, of which, 21 are from Craig and 5 are from Klawock.
- Middle School Wrestling is scheduled to travel to Wrangell as well as Ketchikan this season/year.

As per CCSD's ARPA Mitigation & Prevention Plan, wrestling practices and meets/events must adhere to ASAA COVID-19 Practice & Event Guidelines. Additionally, prior to any meet/event taking place, a meet/event specific mitigation plan will be created, in which requires approval from the Athletic Director, Building Principal, and Superintendent. Additionally, all students and staff members traveling off island for district sponsored extra-curricular events shall receive a COVID-19 test and negative results prior to travel to ensure all CCSD students and staff are symptom free of COVID-19.
