Improvement Activities

- Targeted instructional support from central office Academics staff to support teachers and leaders in planning and implementation of best practices
- Weekly check-in meetings with content directors for data analysis and professional development planning
- Support from Region 4 School Improvement Specialist to identify areas of strength and opportunity

Improvement Activities, Continued

- TEA consult call with Superintendent, Academics team, community superintendent, and principal to review ESF diagnostic summary and to discuss eligibility for a school improvement grant
- Instructional leadership team data meetings after each major assessment to identify strengths, areas of concern, and to adjust action plans

School Improvement Strategy

Campus leaders will facilitate the data-driven instruction process for teachers, individually, and in Professional Learning Communities (PLC) to analyze data, identify trends in student misconceptions, determine the root cause as to why students may have not have learned concepts, and to create plans to reteach and reassess.
