President Haidle appointed Mandy Lovell and Assistant Superintendent Dave Rodgers as tellers. Completed ballots were folded and inserted in a ballot box by each voting member. The tellers counted the ballots and submitted the results to President Haidle.

Votes tallied were in support of electing Andrea Haidle (14 votes) and Anne Hamming (15 votes) to a six-year term (2023-2029) on the Kent ISD School.
