We will continue our discussion regarding part-time students at Tupelo High School. At this point, college credit is available to students through Tupelo High School's Advanced Placement course offerings. In addition to college English and history, students have the opportunity to receive other college level credit for Advanced Placement courses successfully completed and validated by earning the required score on the Advanced Placement examination.

Therefore, it is our recommendation that enrollment in college courses at either community colleges or 4-year institutions of high learning not be approved as a reason for granting "Part-Time Status" to Tupelo High School students.
