- Hosted by the Washington County Community Transition Interagency Committee (CTIC)
- CTIC is a group of Work or Transition Coordinators from school districts in Washington County and outside agency providers who come together to improve outcomes for students transitioning from school to adult life.

CTIC members

- Currently 6 school districts send members to work on the committee
- Outside agencies that have a consistent presence are Washington County Vocational Rehabilitation Services, Washington County Developmental Delay Services, State Services for the Blind, East Suburban Resources, Midwest Special Services and Goodwill/EasterSeals

Work of the Committee

- The Committee
 - Shares updates about legislation and programming/partnerships
 - Works to plan and implement Career Skills Day
 - Develops a Community Transition Resource Guide bi-annually
 - Fulfills MDE requirements for an active CTIC committee

Career Skills Day

- Participating schools send staff and students to partake in this event focused on celebrating student attainment of employability skills
- Each district can send 10 students from each high school and 10 from their 18-21 Transition Program
 - This year approximately 130 student participated
