BOARD POLICY

1. Proposals for the adoption of a new policy or revisions to an existing policy will be presented in writing by the superintendent to the Board for review, discussion, and action. The superintendent will present for the attention of the Board any policy deemed to be inadequate, ineffective, obsolete or in need of revision for other reasons. Actions by the Board or changes in state or federal legislation may require revisions or amendments to certain policies of the Board or administrative regulations. In such instances, the superintendent will present proposed changes to the Board for consideration.

2. In order to maintain current written policies that are consistent with Board action, administrative decisions and controlling law, the Board policies shall be reviewed its policies on a regular annual basis.

3. An existing policy of the Board may be revised or amended at any special or regular meeting upon a vote of a majority of the members present.
