- **Student Achievement** By the end of the 2016-2017 academic year, Earhart will hold an average of 10 monthly Response to Intervention meetings with parent participation.

## Strategies

## **ELA Student Achievement**

\*Implement close reading at least 1x a week.

- \*Use corporation Power standards to focus on important grade level topics.
- \*Post objectives and essential questions to help students understand what they are learning.
- \*Implement Writer's Workshop (K-2) and Simple 6 (3-4) to help with writing instruction.

\*Set aside a 30-minute time each day for differentiated ability grouping focusing on the identified power standards.

#### **Math Student Achievement**

- \*Implement problem solving into daily math lessons.
- \*Directly connect the Indiana math process standards to our curriculum maps.
- \*Use Accelerated Math to help differentiate instruction.
- \*Post objectives and essential questions to help students understand what they are learning.

## Student Achievement

- \*Parents will receive a paper note reminding them of their meeting at least one week ahead of time.
- \* School Messenger System will text parents on the morning of their meeting.

\*Teachers will progress monitor students in the RTI process and meet with parents every 8 weeks to give updates.
