SUBJECT: Intergovernmental Agreements (IGA's) Related to Lincoln and Longfellow Construction

DATE: August 14, 2018

On November 20, 2014, the Board of Education entered into an IGA with the Park District of Oak Park (PDOP) regarding sports field maintenance that, among other provisions, gives PDOP the right to use the sports field adjacent to Longfellow School. The sports field adjacent to Longfellow will be impacted by construction staging activities.

In November 2013, the Board of Education entered into an IGA with the Park District of Oak Park (PDOP) regarding shared use of facilities that, among other provisions, gives PDOP "next priority" use rights (after OP97 and affiliates) to OP97 facilities. The Longfellow and Lincoln school facilities will be unavailable to PDOP during the summer due to construction.

On November 1, 2012, the Board of Education entered into an IGA with the Park District of Oak Park (PDOP) regarding underground irrigation of the Longfellow school field. The irrigation system of the sports field adjacent to Longfellow will be impacted by construction staging activities.

The Board will be asked to authorize administration to partially and temporarily suspend of aspects of each of these agreements at the September 4, 2018 regular meeting.
