

Dress and Grooming

The following are considered inappropriate for all students to wear during the school day:

1. Any unduly revealing attire.
2. Outer coats, windbreakers, hats, scarves, earmuffs, bandanas, curlers, goggles, sunglasses are prohibited indoors.
3. Hooded shirts maybe worn indoors provided the hoods are not used as head apparel.
4. Jewelry or wallet/key chains that can be dangerous or distracting.
5. Cell phones, laser pens or other types of electronic devices which are not prescribed for instructional purposes.
6. No references to drugs, sex, alcohol or obscene remarks.
7. Exemption for all school sanctioned uniforms on designated days by the administration such as prom dresses and school dances.
8. Backpacks/book bags, if permitted by the school administration, may be carried between classes, but shall not obstruct safe passage in the classroom or in the corridors.
