Dress and Grooming

The following are considered inappropriate for all students to wear during the school day:

1. Any unduly revealing attire.

- 2. Outer coats, windbreakers, hats, scarves, earmuffs, bandanas, curlers, goggles, sunglasses are prohibited indoors.
- 3. Hooded shirts maybe worn indoors provided the hoods are not used as head apparel.
- 4. Jewelry or wallet/key chains that can be dangerous or distracting.
- 5. Cell phones, laser pens or other types of electronic devices which are not prescribed for instructional purposes.
- 6. No references to drugs, sex, alcohol or obscene remarks.
- 7. Exemption for all school sanctioned uniforms on designated days by the administration such as prom dresses and school dances.
- 8. Backpacks/book bags, if permitted by the school administration, may be carried between classes, but shall not obstruct safe passage in the classroom or in the corridors.
