Background Information:

The purpose of this board presentation is to provide the MISD Board of Trustees with the annual evaluation report of the Multilingual Education programs for the 2023 - 2024 school year. The Manor ISD Multilingual Education Team provides services to scholars with a language other than English. Currently, we have 46 languages other than English in Manor ISD. 44% of our student population is comprised of Emergent Bilinguals, formerly known as English Learners. Per Texas Administrative Code (TAC) 89.1265, all school districts required to have a bilingual education or ESL program shall conduct an annual evaluation and report to the board of trustees before November 1st of each year. Annual school district reports of educational performance shall reflect the academic progress in the language(s) of instruction for English learners, the extent to which English learners are becoming proficient in English, and the number of students who have been reclassified as proficient in English. Also, documentation of the district's professional learning efforts, including all information on teachers with a bilingual education exception or ESL waiver, can be reported. Furthermore, districts may also consider other anecdotal programmatic data to include that can demonstrate growth.
