

**Ector County
Literacy Support Proposal
2013-2014**

Goliad ISD and Ector County ISD, working collaboratively to improve student performance in the areas of reading, agree to the following arrangement.

ROLE OF Ector County ISD

- Provide Guided Reading Training for Goliad ISD teachers in the grade levels of kindergarten through 4th grade.
- Ector County ISD Reading consultants will provide no less than 4 total consultant days in order to:
 - Partner with Goliad ISD in implementing an evidenced-based literacy program.
 - Train Goliad ISD teachers in best practices and standards-based instructional strategies for reading, which are designed to provide the highest yield in student achievement.
 - Support Reading teachers in the implementation of research-based techniques and strategies.

ROLE OF Goliad ISD

- Goliad ISD Reading teachers will attend and actively participate in all designated professional development sessions in order to provide students of Goliad ISD with quality Guided Reading instruction.

COSTS

Authorized representatives of Goliad ISD enter into the above-described agreement for a fee of \$5,500.
