STAAR Redesign

State and Federal laws require a redesign of Texas's state summative assessment (STAAR), effective 2022-2023 school year

*These policies are intended to ensure
assessments engage students in the same
ways they are learning in the classroom and
reward good instruction while continuing to
accurately measure student mastery*

The extended constructed response item, or essay question, will ask students to write in one of three possible modes: **informational, argumentative, or correspondence**. (In the past, the only possible mode was informational).



Extended constructed response items will be **scored using a 5-point** rubric. The 2 main components- Idea Development and Language Convention



There will be an increase in the number of cross-curricular informational passages that reference content aligned to the TEKS for other subject areas (e.g., social studies, science, mathematics, fine arts, etc.). While the cross-curricular passages will include topics from other subject areas, the **questions will only assess RLA TEKS**.



STAAR RLA tests administered in April through December 2022 will include only items that assess the 2017 TEKS

STAAR REDESIGN

In the classroom, strong teachers are supporting students becoming better readers by...

- Having students ***write in ALL grade*** levels and **ALL** subject areas.
- Having students ***write using evidence from texts*** they are reading.

STAAR is getting redesigned based on these two practices.





Remote Learning

SB Remote Learning Eligibility Requirements

Be enrolled in a school district or open enrollment charter school.

The student **achieved satisfactory achievement or higher on each STAAR/EOC assessments administered in Spring 2021.** ***If a STAAR assessment was not administered, a Beginning of Year (BOY) assessment will be used***

The students in **K-3rd grade achieved grade level proficiency in TEKS.** Other assessments that will be used include; BOY (Fall 2021), End of Year (EOY)(Spring 2021), TPRI(Spring 2021), Tejas LEE(Spring 2021), and CPALLS(Spring 2021).

The student has **18 or less absences (10 percent) out of all instructional days for the 2020-2021 school year.** Based on student information from the current school year, the student has fewer than 10 unexcused absences.

The student earned a **C or higher in the foundation curriculum (English Language Arts and Reading, Math, Science and Social Studies) courses taken virtually or remotely in the preceding school year.**
