February was a busy month for the students. Our students are continuing to work daily in Math, Reading/Writing, Social Studies, English/Spelling, Science, Health/PE, Blackfeet History/Culture. Students researched and compiled reports about U.S. Presidents, Native American Leaders and Sports athletes, and African American Leaders and Sports athletes. All reports were read aloud for the class by the writers. 3-8th grade students also had nominations and voting on who would be the new colony bosses as a mock vote event. We still have a few open positions that we will have a new round of voting for soon.

The 7th and 8th grade students performed several Science investigative experiments on electricity, physical dynamics/energy, fabrication of recycled materials. 1st and 2nd graders performed investigative experiments on weights and measurements, liquid density. 3rd-6th graders performed investigative reporting using their textbooks and chrome/iPad resources. They completed their findings through report completion papers.

Despite the cold and flu season upon us, our attendance has been at or near 100% this month and our students are to be commended. Students performed the annual Writing Assessment that is required yearly and at the completion of the period, refreshments/treats were enjoyed as a reward. We also attended a virtual field trip as a class reward; the trip was about the NBA Storytellers and it was a valuable learning experience.
