Dear Superintendent Little,

CONGRATULATIONS! Boyne City Public Schools will be receiving a 2% award from the Grand Traverse Band of Ottawa & Chippewa Indians (GTB) for the 1st half 2024 2% cycle in the amount of **\$15,000** for the Boyne Area Title VI Educational Consortium cultural program as outlined in your 2% application.

Unfortunately, due to unforeseen circumstances, there will not be a media event held this cycle. You will be receiving the award check in the mail separate from this letter.

Under the terms of the consent decree settling *Tribes v. Engler* (Case No. 1:90 CV 611 U.S. Dist. Ct. West. Dist. Mich.), the Grand Traverse Band of Ottawa and Chippewa Indians agreed to pay 2% of its video gaming revenue as defined in the stipulation, no later than 60 days after October 1st and March 31st of each year. This payment schedule was modified with the consent of the State of Michigan to July 31st and January 31st of each year because the fiscal year of the Grand Traverse Band gaming operation is calendar-based.

A requirement of receiving this grant is to provide a short report on the expenditure of funds for each grant you receive one year from date of receipt of this 2% award.
