

**Dates of Importance for the  
November 3, 2009 School Board Election:**

<b>August 11, 2009</b>	Last day to publish notice of filing dates for the general election if your district is NOT subject to the primary election system.
<b>August 15, 2009</b>	Last day to post notice of the filing dates for the general election. <b>Note: Because this date falls on a Saturday, school districts should post this by Friday, August 14.</b>
<b>August 25, 2009</b>	First day to file for general election if your district is NOT subject to the primary election system (not less than 70 days before the second Tuesday in November).
<b>September 8, 2009</b>	Last day to file for general election if your district is NOT subject to the primary election system.
<b>September 10, 2009</b>	Last day to file affidavit of withdrawal if your district is NOT subject to the primary election system.
<b>September 11, 2009</b>	Last day to adopt resolution calling the general election. (53 days prior to date of election).
<b>September 11, 2009</b>	Last day to notify county auditors of the date of the general election and the questions or offices to be voted on.
<b>October 4, 2009</b>	First day absentee ballots must be available for general election (30 days prior to election). <b>Because this date falls on a Sunday, districts should have ballots available Friday, October 2.</b> Also, master list is available from the county for school district absentee voting.
<b>October 9, 2009</b>	<b>Last day to appoint election judges.</b> Last day to notify voters of a polling place change for the November general election.
<b>October 13, 2009</b>	Last day to preregister for November election (at least 21 days prior to date of election).
<b>October 14, 2009</b>	Last day for the operator of a residential facility to provide to the county a certified list of employees eligible to vote for residents of the facility (at least 20 days before the election). Also, first day election judges shall deliver absentee ballots to eligible voters who are temporary or permanent residents in a healthcare facility or hospital in the school district.
<b>October 20, 2009</b>	Last day to publish first notice of November general election. Also first day to do public accuracy test of electronic voting equipment (notice of this test should be published at least 2 days before the test).
<b>October 24, 2009</b>	Last day to post notice of November general election (at least 10 days prior to date of the election). <b>Because this date falls</b>

	<b>on a Saturday, districts should post notice by Friday, October 23. Campaign finance reports are due.</b>
<b>October 27, 2009</b>	Last day to publish second notice of November general election. Final updated voter registration master list must be available. Also, first day agent delivery of absentee ballots to voters unable to get to the polls (during the seven days preceding an election and until 2 p.m. on Election Day).
<b>October 30, 2009</b>	Last day to post sample ballot of November general election (at least 4 days prior to date of election).
<b>November 2, 2009</b>	Last day to apply for absentee ballot for November election (day prior to date of election). Also last day to do public accuracy test of electronic voting equipment. Also, last day for election judges to secure election supplies from the school district clerk.
<b>November 3, 2009</b>	Election day. Minimum voting hours are 10 a.m. to 8 p.m. in metro districts,
<b>November 10, 2009</b>	Last day to adopt resolution canvassing for November election.
<b>January 4, 2010</b>	Terms begin for members elected in 2009 general election.
