Any long-term asset meeting the capitalization threshold of <b>\$5,000</b> are capitalized and depreciated. Asset reports by building and room are issued in March of each year for each building and room. The secretary at each building reports back on the status of each asset including assets that moved location or needing disposal. The technology department is notified for any electronic assets to be moved or disposed of through commercial recycling. Information and pictures of other assets to be disposed of are sent to the accounting secretary to post for public surplus and sold at auction.
