Justification for additional teacher

- OPI and BHS Requirement:
 - Freshman must take 1 semester of Health
 - All students must have 2 semesters of PE over two years
- There are students that want to be in PE and/or Conditioning but can't be because of already overloaded classes.
- The conditioning classes are at capacity, with the exception of the 3rd period
- BHS is already limited in its availability of electives.
- Many upperclassmen students are struggling to earn their PE credits needed for graduation because they suffer from self-esteem/body-image/anxiety issues. These students would surely benefit from smaller PE class sizes and potentially an alternative type of PE that focused on ways to cope with these issues.

- Our community has high diabetes, heart disease, and obesity rate
- We also have a high number of students that have ADHD as well as other mental health issues (such as anxiety or depression) and benefit from taking a PE class every semester during their four years of high school

WITH A THIRD TEACHER:
