Secretary Key,

We applied for school choice for our son, William Roy Birdsong, prior to May 1, 2021. His resident school district is Ozark Mountain School District and we intent for him to attend Valley Springs School District. I got a letter in the mail on 6/1/21, letter dated 5/26/21 that he was denied school choice from Ozark Mountain School District due to them being at max capacity to allow additional students to school choice to other school districts. He has been placed on the waiting list for school choice.

William has already registered for Kindergarten at Valley Springs School District. We filled out his school choice form and had it post marked prior to May 1, 2021 and then signed him up for kindergarten registration at Valley Springs School District, where we intend for him to receive his education. It was unexpected that the school choice request was denied. We wish to appeal the decision of denial for William Roy Birdsong's application of school choice.

It is essential that William be able to attend Valley Springs School Districts for many reasons. We, as a family, are unable to participate in a 4 day a week school week. We do not have any family that live in the area that are able to assist with child care. Both parents work 5 days a week and would be unable to provide childcare on the 5th day of the 4 day a week school week. Due to both parents work schedule and location of work locations, we would be unable to drop William off at school and pick him up at school in a timely manner. We both work mainly in the Harrison area and our other son's childcare facility is located in Harrison, so Valley Springs is much closer and we would be able to drop him off at school and pick him up from school without difficulty. William has sensory processing disorder and he is unable to ride the bus at this time.

William has trouble with unexpected change and with overall change in general. He has gone through multiple changes in his life in the last year. He has gained a new baby brother in January, his father began a new job in November, and he will be moving from Montessori in Harrison to Kindergarten. All of which he has been having trouble navigating through. He is shy and apprehensive of new situations and has sensory processing disorder. He has already registered for Kindergarten at Valley Springs School District, and I fear that if he were unable to

attend Valley Springs School for kindergarten it would be very challenging for him to accept. We have been preparing him for years that he would be attending "big boy" school at Valley Springs. He talks about Valley Springs as the "big boy" school he will be attending. If he were unable to attend Valley Springs for his Kindergarten year, it would put him at a disadvantage. If he were unable to attend Valley Springs for kindergarten, he would not be able to begin school with his peers to begin developing those relationships, he would be unable to become familiar with the school prior to attending, and it would create a hardship for him and his family due to the 4 day a week school week and no readily available childcare.

We are asking that the Department of Education reconsider his school choice and allow him to attend Valley Springs School District beginning with his kindergarten year, the 2021-2022 school year. This decision to allow him to attend Valley Springs School would benefit William and the entire family. Thank you for your consideration.
